**MEDITATION.**

**KINGDOM LIFESTYLES: HOLINESS.**

**Text: “No,” said Peter, “You shall never wash my feet.” Jesus answered, “Unless I wash you, you have no part with me.” Jesus answered, A person who has had a bath needs only to wash his feet; his whole body is clean. And you are clean, though not every one of you.” John 13:8&10.**

Looking at holiness from Spiritual perspective, it has to do with the state or quality of being holy, purity, or integrity of moral character. This can only be found in the Supreme Being which if critically looked into is one of God’s essential attributes.

The writer of the book Exodus says “Who is like Thee, O Lord, among the gods? Who is like Thee, Majestic in holiness, terrible in glorious deeds, doing wonders? Exod. 15:11. This is telling us God’s complete separation from the finite, from frailty, and from all that is sinful or impure. This holiness of the Lord is incomparable and unequal. The bible tells us that, “There is non holy like the Lord, there is non beside Thee; there is no rock like God” 1 Sam. 2:2. If we dig deeper, this holiness of God may be seen in His character, that was why the psalmist said, “Yet thou art holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.” Ps. 22:3. For you and I, the Psalmist challenged us, when he says “Sing praises to the Lord, O you His saints, and give thanks to His Holy Name.” Ps 30:4. We are to praise Him for His Holiness and imitate Him in His purity and integrity.

Holiness is commanded by God Himself. He challenged the Israelites, “Consecrate

yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the Lord your God". Lev 20:7.

Peter the Apostle refused Jesus to wash his feet, for him to be holy for the Kingdom of God. Jesus told him, if I do not wash you, you have no part in Me," that is in my Kingdom. This same Peter in his first letter now calls on would be Christians that, "As obedient Children, do not be conformed to the passions of your former ignorance, but as He who called you is holy, be holy yourselves in all your conduct; since it is written, "You shall be holy, for I am holy." 1 Peter. 1:14-16, Lev. 11:44. We are to live a holy life devoid of filthiness. Prophet Isaiah was not fit for the purpose for which God needs him until the tongs from the altar touched his mouth. He was separated from the common and profane life style to a divine life. Many of us today have been consecrated through the water of regeneration during our baptism, added to this, we have undergone the rite of today have been consecrated through the water of regeneration.

confirmation which could have set us apart for God's kingdom. But we discovered that many are living a filthy life. Do you know what? (1) Let us remind ourselves that your attendance in every regular services or occasional services does not make you holy. (2) Your participation in the conduct of services does not make you holy. (3) How expensive or costly your dressing to any of the services on Sunday does not have anything to do with your holiness to God that you come to worship. (4) Do you know or realize that not how dutiful in your going up and down during any of the services makes you holy before God? (5) Let me quickly add this, not how fat or big your collections or tithes or donations envelopes that makes you holy before the Almighty and all seeing God, but that being delivered from the hand of our enemies, might serve Him without fear in Holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of your life. Lk. 1:74-75. We need to examine our life styles in line with the commands of the Lord. God challenged the Israel to stop religious filthiness and vain worship. Isaiah 1:11-15.

We can then ask ourselves, what then makes my lifestyle worthy and acceptable before God so as for me to be holy before Him, and to be fit for His kingdom?

God said: 1. Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean, Not like COVID-19 washing of hands. 2. Remove the evil of your doings from before My eyes. 3. Cease to do evil, 4. Learn to do good, 5. Seek Justice, 6. Correct oppression, 7. Defend the Fatherless, 8. Plead for the widow. Isaiah 1:16-17.

Haven't you and I cleared of all the above mentioned filthiness, God is now calling on us: "come now, let us reason together, says the Lord though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be white as snow; though they are red like crimson they shall become like wool." Isaiah 1:18.

My dear people of God, Holiness belongs to God, no controversy, no contention. You must be morally perfect, upright and be free from all limitation caused by Satan that leads to sin. Jettison every sinful acts. God is here this morning calling on us to share in His Holiness. He is in His magnanimity ready to impart to our souls the spiritual regeneration which is the source of holy character and lifestyles that makes up His Kingdom. No unrighteous man will be there to pollute His kingdom. Are you ready, then join me in singing:

**BIBLE STUDY**  
**TRINITY FOUR**  
**SUNDAY, JULY 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2020.**

**THEME:** In The Name Of Jesus Christ

**SUB-THEME:** Attributes of Jesus Christ (10)

**TOPIC:** Omniscience

**TEXTS:** *Matthew 9:4-5; John 2: 24-25*

**AIMS:**

- i. To discover the mysteries and magnitude of the knowledge of Jesus and*
- ii. To experience the acknowledgment of Jesus' omniscience by His followers.*

**Introduction:**

Omniscience is a theological term that refers to God's superior universal knowledge and wisdom. God knows everything from eternity past to eternity future simultaneously without consulting anyone for knowledge or understanding. (*Psalm. 139: 1-6*) The Texts today reveal Jesus Christ as omniscient. This study shall further show how the disciples acknowledged the omniscience of Jesus Christ.

**Study Guide:**

1. Explain the word “Omni-science” and what we mean when we say God is Omniscient? *Psalm 139: 1-6; 147: 4-5; Isa. 40:26; Matt. 10: 30?*
2. How did Jesus manifest the omniscience of God on earth? *Matt 9:4-5; Mark 2:8; John 2:24-25; 6:64.*
3. What are the mysteries and magnitude of the omniscience of Jesus? *John 4: 16-19, 28-29; 10: 14-16.*
4. In what ways did the early Apostles acknowledge the omniscience of Jesus Christ? *John 16:30; Acts 1: 24-25; 1 Cor. 4: 5.*

**Conclusion:** No human being on earth had ever displayed the omniscience of God as our Lord Jesus Christ who knows all things from the beginning of the age till the end of the age. To Him we should commit our souls and spirits.
