There is something common to kings Jeroboam. Ahab and Ahaziah-involvement in idolatry. Apart from Jeroboam, the other two kings were negatively influenced by their wives and mother respectively. Jeroboam dumped the God of Israel to set up an idol at Bethel and thus misled the whole nation. Ahab ran a battle against Prophet Elijah. Ahaziah followed the footsteps of Ahab. This study unveils their atrocious acts and the consequences that followed the failure of leadership of the three kings.
