## MEDITATION.

### **NATURE OF HIS KINGDOM: THE LIVING REALITY.**

***Text: But our citizenship is in heaven. Phil. 3:20a***

We are beginning another series of our teaching on the theme for the year which is Kingdom Manifestation.

Nature is the basic features, character, or qualities of something. Reality simply means the state of things as they actually exist. Several people have described the Kingdom of God as an imagination and also teach that there is no resurrection of the dead. **1 Cor. 15:12.** This was part of the belief of the Sadduces. **Acts 23:8.** In our world today, many believe that the Kingdom of God is not real and they do not believe the communion of Saints.

From our text, Jesus promised the believers that He was going to prepare a place for us, where we shall live together forever. Apostle Paul asserted that both the living and the dead shall meet with the Lord to ascend to the Kingdom where we shall live with Christ as the King. "For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangels and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will be with the Lord forever. I Thess. 4:16-17.

Beloved things around us are enough to mislead, misdirect and divert our attention away from becoming the citizen of the Kingdom. But we must not allow our faith to shake. "Beware see to it that no one takes you captive through hollow and deceptive philosophy which depends on human tradition and the basics principles of this world rather than on Christ. **Col. 2:8.**

Heaven is a place where all believers shall live together forever. "***But our citizenship is in heaven***" **Phil 3:20.** As we eagerly await the return of the King of the Kingdom, Our Lord Jesus Christ. We must perform our citizenship roles and obligations for us to secure a right to the Kingdom. Jesus promised that He was going to prepare a place for us and He will come back to take us home to live forever. In my Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. John 14:2.

May the Lord prepare us and help us to do those things that will qualify us for the citizenship of the heavenly Kingdom.

## BIBLE STUDY

### TRINITY FOURTEEN SUNDAY, 13<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2020

**Sub Theme:** The Supremacy of Jesus Christ over Biblical heroes (5)

**Topic:** Jesus and Joshua

**Texts:** Hebrews 4: 1-11

### **Aims:**

- i. To identify the relationship between Jesus Christ and Joshua and
- ii. To justify the supremacy of Jesus Christ over Joshua
- iii. To discuss further on the promised land through Joshua and eternal life through Jesus Christ

**Introduction:** The word 'Yeh-hoshua' (Hebrew) and 'Iesous' (Greek) share the same meaning i.e. “Jehovah is salvation” but the context of their usage is quite different. Joshua was the successor of Moses in the quest to take the people of God (Israelite) to the Promised Land (*Josh. 1:1-7*) while Jesus Christ offered himself as a sacrifice for the redemption of the world from sin and eternal damnation (*John 3: 16, Matt. 1:20-21*). This study will further prove the supremacy of Jesus Christ over Joshua.

### **Study Guide/Questions:**

1. Personally to you, who are Joshua and Jesus? State the similarity between their missions. *Deut. 3:27-28; John 3:16; Rom. 5:1-2.*
2. Compare the rest given by Joshua to that in Jesus Christ. *Josh 23:1; Judges 1:1; Matt 11:27-30; John 14:27-28.*
3. Highlight the supremacy of Jesus over Joshua during challenging situations. *Josh 7:1, 24-26; Josh 24:29-30; Luke 23:33-34, 39-43; Luke 24:5-7*
4. “So, I swore in my anger, they will not enter my rest” (*Psalms 95:11*). What are the factors that led to this statement? *Num 14:20-23; Num 32:6-11.* How can we avoid such comment from God?

**Conclusion:** Joshua settled the Israelites in Canaan as their resting place. This rest in Canaan wasn't real; Israel had unending problems with the Canaanites. However, Jesus has a rest for all who have faith in him, an eternal rest with no more weeping, no sorrow and hardship; but endless joy in the presence of God.

**Food For Thought:** Seek to inherit eternal life because all earth's rest is only temporal.

**Memory Verse:** *Hebrews 4:11* “Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience”.
