SUB THEME: GODLY LEADERSHIP AND CHRISTIAN
TOPIC: Patterns of Christian Discipleship (Types, methods).
TEXTS: Luke 6:12-16; 2 Tim. 2:2.

DISCIPLESHIP.

AIMS: To:

- i. *understand what is Christian Discipleship and its implications;*
- ii. *discover the discipleship methods of Christ and the early Church, with their impact;*

iii. *help us chart a course for effective discipleship in the Church.*

INTRODUCTION:

In the first study under this sub-theme, we have examined the relationship between godly leadership and Christian Discipleship. In this study, our chief concern will be the 'strategy' or 'methods' for Christian Discipleship. To this end, we will examine the methods of Christ and that of the early Church in the Gospels. The intension is to transform discipleship efforts in our Churches, even where it may involve a radical change of direction.

STUDY GUIDE

1. Define and discuss Christian Discipleship in the light of *Mark.10:21 and John 21:15-19.*
2. How did Jesus and the early Church do discipleship?
 - a. Selection of a few who have made commitment to the faith – *Luke 6:12-13; 2 Tim.2:2.*
 - b. Personal and relational association *Mk 3:14; Acts 16:1-3:1 Cor.11:1.*
 - c. Training of the selected few through real life experiences – *Matt.10:1, 5-8; Luke 10:1-9, 17; 2 Tim.2:2.*
3. What was the outcome of the above discipleship efforts? *Luke 6:12-16; Acts 2:41, 47; 5:14; 6:7; 17:4; 19:20.*
4. In the light of the above, what does God's Church today need to change or improve upon for effective discipleship? *Luke 6:12-16; Acts 2:41, 47; 5:14; 6:7; 17:4; 19:20.*

CONCLUSION: If Christ had set out raising disciples without a clear cut strategy, He would have failed in His mission to save the world. The early Church took off from where Christ had left off, and the result is what we have today as God's Church. Having a crowd is good, but sizeable, trainable, and multiplied disciples under a relational atmosphere remain the best bet.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT: *Lack of clear-cut strategy is an open invitation to failure in Christian discipleship.*

TODAY'S MEDITATION

TRUE OBEDIENCE

Noah did everything just as God commanded him. Gen 6:22.

Obedience is compliance with an order, request, law or submission to another's authority.

God's clear instructions to the very first human beings Adam and Eve in the garden of Eden was to refrain from eating the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil (Gen 2:16). He expected their obedience. They disobeyed, thereby losing initial favor with God. The obedience of Abraham is perhaps most exemplary in the Old Testament. On two occasions, he demonstrated total submission to God's will. First, he obeyed God's command to go to a new land (Gen 12). This response meant leaving Ur of the Chaldees, a highly developed city, to go to the unknown, unfamiliar land that God would show to him the land of Canaan. Second, he obeyed God's command to offer his son as a sacrifice (Gen 22:1-19).

Our Lord Jesus Christ was obedient even to the point of death. Obedience is an attitude of heart toward a higher authority.

As Christians, that higher authority is God Himself. Jesus said in John 14:15, "If ye love

Me, keep My commandments." Thus, true obedience means to hear, trust, submit and surrender to God and his Word.

Brethren, how obedience are you to the commands of God, do you keep His words and act accordingly. No one can please the Lord without obedience. Remember Lot, king Saul and the young prophet in 1 Kings. 13. They all failed to obey God and ended in disaster.

It is my prayer that we shall all be obedience children so that all the blessings promised shall be ours in Jesus name.
